The New West Market Parking Sticker/Hang Tag Requirements

General Sticker/Hang Tag Requirement

Any vehicle parked longer than twenty-four hours in a West Market unreserved street space may be towed at the owner's expense unless it has a West Market parking sticker or hang tag. If you park in your garage or driveway, you do not need a sticker so it is up to residents if they want to register -- except in Madison Park, where all residents must register regardless. Towing companies are **not** authorized to patrol the neighborhood.

What vehicles qualify for stickers/hang tags?

Any vehicle that is (a) currently registered to a West Market resident, regardless of State of registration, or (b) currently registered to a West Market resident's employer or corporate entity that is intended for the resident's regular personal or business use. Proof of West Market residence or employment/corporate relationship (for employer/company cars) may be required.

How many stickers/hang tags can one obtain?

Madison Park residents (by vote of its condo board) are limited to no more than two stickers per unit without prior written approval of the Madison Park Board, and hang tags will generally not be available. For the rest of West Market, so many stickers as there are vehicles that qualify, and residents may choose a hang tag in lieu of one sticker (no more than one hang tag per unit, to be used only by the resident to whom it was issued or his/her guests). Temporary permits may be considered for extenuating circumstances (such as a family member moving in for a long period).

How does one obtain stickers?

The Madison Park Board will notify its residents by mail on its registration procedures. All other residents can download the form from our web site and register with the On-Site Manager by e-mail (preferred), fax, mail, or hand delivery. Registration sessions will also be held on Saturdays Feb. 9, 16, and 23, 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., at the Club House.

How long are stickers/hang tags good for?

Two-year cycles, to limit parking by individuals who move out of the neighborhood.

What about guest passes?

There are no guest passes. Guests have a 24-hour grace period (accommodating up to overnight stays). Thereafter guests can park in a unit's private parking, move their vehicles to a different street space, or use the unit's hang tag (if one was obtained).
